A former member of the Ku Klux Klan, he once jumped on a stage at Birmingham Alabama, and tried to attack Nat King Cole, then performing. He was also in the group that was charged with the burning of the first bus of freedom riders outside Birmingham. He was recently ~~again~~ convicted to 180 days in jail and fined a \$100 on counts of firing shotgun blasts into a church and the home of two Negroes. (Washington Post, 5/26/63)

Adams, Alabama; head of the National States Rights Party
