## Testifies on

### Agnew Party

ANNAPOLIS, Md., July 24, (AP)—The Anne Arundel County grand jury heard 90 minutes of testimony yesterday from the Rev. Roy Pfautch, the political consultant who helped organize the 1972 Salute To Ted Agnew Night fund-raiser.

The Presbyterian minister left the jury room carrying two large briefcases but refused to answer any questions concerning his voluntary appearance.

The jury spent nearly 2½ hours hearing testimony from Mr. Pfautch and Sgt. Lee Apperson, an Anne Arundel County detective who has been working on the investigation into financial reports from the Agnew affair.

Mr. Pfautch operates a political consulting firm, Civic Services, Inc. in St. Louis. Agnew affair records state that the firm was paid \$8,000 for work on the May, 1972, gala in Baltimore at the Lyric Theatre.

Marlin S. Wolf, deputy county state's attorney, said that the jury probe of the financial records of the affair will continue and that "very possibly" other witnesses will be called next Tuesday.
