Nixon Secluded At Camp David

CAMP DAVID, Md., April 29 (AP)—President Nixon remained secluded today at his mountaintop retreat as pressure grew for action on the Watergate case.

Reliable sources said that Mr. Nixon was no longer alone at the camp 75 miles northwest of Washington—that he had been joined by a small cadre of advisers. But the White House refused to divulge any information on Mr. Nixon's activities.

"The President is spending a private weekend at Camp David and I cannot provide information at this time," said deputy White House press secretary Gerald L. Warren.
