WASHINGTON — (UPI) — Treasury Department figures show that only 3 per cent of all national bank charter applications in the past five years have been approved as fast as one granted a Minnesota investor who gave \$25,000 to President Nixon's campaign.

The figures were in a letter that Comptroller of the Currency William Camp sent yesterday to Rep. Wright Patman (D-Tex.), chairman of the House Banking Committee.

The summary showed that only 13 of 424 applications get approved in less than 36 days, the time it took to grant a charter Aug. 22 to Dwayne Andreas.
