

## Watergate Figure <sup>Post</sup> 9-25-74

NEW HAVEN—Alfred C. Baldwin, the former FBI agent who was the first to admit a role in the Watergate break-in at Democratic headquarters, has a new job as a junior high school teacher in New Haven.

Baldwin will be teaching mathematics at the Sheridan Middle School at an annual salary of \$11,150.

The New Haven Board of Education approved Baldwin's appointment Monday.

School Superintendent George Barbarito said Baldwin was hired on the strength of his performance as a substitute teacher at the Sheridan school last spring.

Asked if he had any qualms about hiring a person with Baldwin's reputation, Barbarito said, "Positively not."
