**Bugging Suspect
Released on Bond**

Bernard L. Barker, one of the five suspects in the Watergate bugging case, was released from jail yesterday after posting a \$40,000 bond.

Barker's release leaves only Frank Sturgis in D.C. jail. According to conditions of release set by Judge James A. Belson, Sturgis also must post a full \$40,000 to gain his release.

According to the conditions of his release, Barker, who is charged with second-degree burglary in connection with an apparent attempt to bug the headquarters of the Democratic National Committee, will live at his home in Miami, Fla., and report in person four days a week to the local bail agency there.
