Liddy's message to Hunt, "the signals have changed & his to stay put"
Hunt told Bennett "I wish they'd make up their minds."

33-34 Des Barker of WH called to check if Hunt had been to work that day
34-5 Hunt on 11/4 Tuesday 20. Phone conversation. Liddy had told Bennett Hunt had gone to NY to work on TV spot. Bennett said if Hunt didn't come back that day

"to explain" had "be forced to suspend him from his job."
