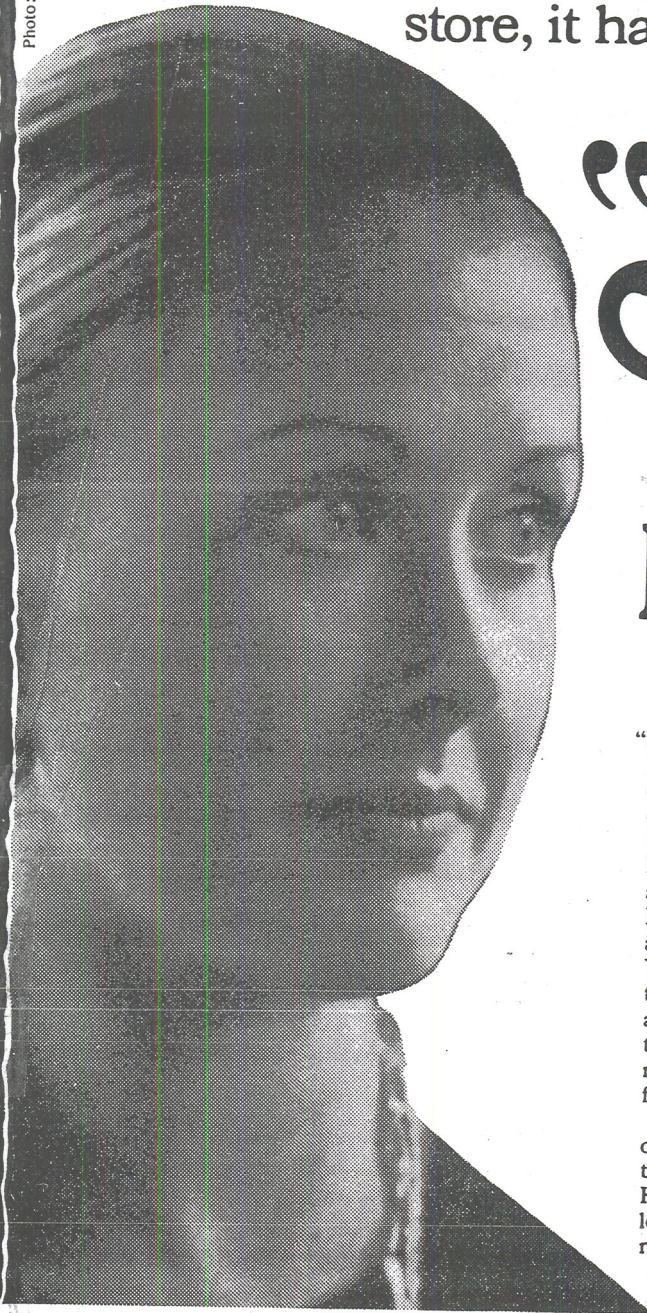

"MO" is a fascinating view of the final, desperate hours of the Nixon administration—by the wife of Watergate's star witness, John Dean. With candor and a keen eye, Maureen Dean exposes the unreported side of the scandal. She describes Donald Segretti's first confessions to her husband and the grim reaction to them; she is there when Dean plays the Colson-Hunt tapes for Ehrlichman and Haldeman, and then when he flies to New York to play them for John Mitchell; she brings the reader close to the President, Mrs. Nixon, Julie and Tricia aboard Air Force One; she wanders through Camp David, intrigued by the appointments of power, while her husband writes the famous Dean Report to the President.

"MO" is a very private and original exploration of the men and women (and their families) inextricably trapped in the Nixon tapes and the White House lies—as well as the compelling story of a love affair and marriage which survived one of the most awesome crises in modern history.
