The White House acknowledged today the probable existence of a tape recording of a 1971 meeting between President Nixon and leaders of the dairy industry that occurred just before the Administration announced a major milk price support increase.

The fact that the dairy industry made a \$422,100 contribution to the President's re-election campaign shortly thereafter has resulted in a suit brought by Raiph Nader and several consumer organizations.

The suit charges the Administration with "improperly and unlawfully" increasing the price supports and seeks the public disclosure of documents.
