The footnote on page 2 of the CIA memorandum of 31 January 1964 in regard to the activity of Lee Harvey Oswald in Mexico City from 28 September through 3 October 1963 refers to certain reports concerning Lee Harvey Oswald which were sent between CIA and other governmental departments and agencies prior to the assassination of President Kennedy. The Commission would appreciate receiving copies of the following, all of which are mentioned in the footnote referred to above:

1. The "biographic information developed by CIA" in response to an inquiry from the Department of State on 25 October 1960.
2. The reply by CIA to the aforementioned Department of State inquiry which was made on 3 November 1960.
3. The reply made by CIA to the aforementioned Department of State inquiry which was made on 21 November 1960.
4. Copies of all disseminations received by CIA from the Department of State, the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Department of the Navy, from the date of the first such dissemination to be received until the date of the assassination of President Kennedy.
