

Third U.S. aide hired by UAL

The third man to move from the Nixon administration to United Air Lines is Monte Lazarus, former administrative assistant to the Civil Aeronautics Board chairman. Lazarus was hired by the airline as a vice president-public affairs.

Earlier this year, United announced it was hiring John P. Olsson, deputy secretary of transportation as assistant to the president, and Dwight L. Chapin, President Nixon's appointments secretary, as director of market development.
