Equal Treatment

Vowed for Colson

MONTGOMERY, Ala., Sept. 20 (UPI) — Former White House special counsel Charles W. Colson will be treated like other inmate in the federal prison at Maxwell Air Force Base here, prison superintendent R. W. Grunski says.

Colson began serving his sentence of 1 to 3 years Tuesday after he pleaded guilty to obstruction of justice in connection with Daniel Ellsberg's trial.

Grunski said Colson's previous association with the White House and publicity from Watergate would neither help nor hurt him in his stay in the prison.
