Tax Support Of Campaign Asked in N.J.

TRENTON, Feb. 12 (UPI)—Gov. Brendan T. Byrne Monday introduced legislation calling for taxpayers to finance gubernatorial elections beginning in 1977.

If the measure becomes law, New Jersey will be the first state in the nation to have public financing of such elections.

Byrne's measure also would place a \$600 limit on the amount of money an individual or corporation could contribute to a gubernatorial candidate.
