**AMPI Suing
Former Aide
Over Funds**

LITTLE ROCK, Oct. 18 (UPI)—Associated Milk Producers, Inc., filed suit in U.S. District Court Thursday against David L. Parr of North Little Rock to recover \$222,450 in AMPI corporate funds that Parr conspired to donate to political campaigns.

Parr, formerly second in command at AMPI before being ousted in early 1972, pleaded guilty in Washington July 23 to a charge filed against him by the Watergate special prosecutor's office involving illegal campaign contributions of \$222,450 from AMPI funds.

In January, Parr pleaded guilty in Little Rock to an indictment charging him with conspiring in 1968 to illegally donate \$22,000 in AMPI corporate funds to the Humphrey-Muskie campaign.

AMPI, as a corporate body, pleaded guilty in July in Washington to conspiring to make some of the same illegal contributions Parr admitted. AMPI was fined \$35,000 on its guilty plea.
