Electric Firm Figure Fined In Nixon Gift

Charles N. Huseman, former president of HMS Electric Corp., pleaded quilty yesterday in connection with an illegal corporate contribution of \$5,000 to President Nixon's reelection campaign.

Huseman was fined the maximum \$1,000 by U.S. District Court Judge George L. Hart Jr. for the one-court misdemeanor. The charge also carried a possible sentence of one year in prison.

"I did this thing," Huseman said in a short appeal for leniency. "I realize it's wrong,"

His attorney also pointed out that Huseman is a grandfather and has no previous criminal record.

Huseman was of the founders of the Washington electrical firm, which since has been purchased by another firm and no longer has the same name.
