\$1 Million Left From GOP Push

Republican National Committee members reportedly have been told a record \$58 million was raised for the 1972 election. One source said only \$1 million was left.

Several persons who attended a closed session, which included a briefing by Maurice Stans, outgoing chairman of the Republican National Finance Committee, said they were unsure just how much money was spent.

Stans, according to the Associated Press, told the committee that the GOP originally set a budget of \$40 million, actually raised \$50 million and spent \$48 million. In addition, the finance committee reportedly raised another \$8 million.

One source said the national committee owes money but that four other party fund-raising groups, not including the reelection committee, have between \$750,000 and \$1 million left.
