Nixon Campaign Aide Denies Fraud Charge

CHICAGO, Dec. 8 (UPI)—
William H. Rentschler, manager of President Nixon's 1968 Chicago area campaign, pleaded innocent Friday to charges he schemed to defraud 28 banks on loans totaling more than \$1 million.

Rentschler appeared briefly with his attorneys in U.S. District Court. A 23-count indictment charges that he made false statements to obtain loans or extensions of loans in an attempt to get money to keep solvent his various businesses.
