

serving a prison sentence of one to four years for his confessed role in the Watergate cover-up. He is being kept at a nearby facility in order to be available to testify in the cover-up trial of five former Nixon aides that began this week.

The D.C. appeals court, last November suspended Dean from practicing law, pending a final recommendation from the D.C. disciplinary bar. Rather than face the bar proceedings, Dean submitted his resignation from the bar, triggering the court action.

Dean Disbarred *Post 10-3*

The D.C. Court of Appeals has disbarred former presidential counsel John W. Dean III from practicing law in the District of Columbia.

Dean, already disbarred by Virginia and banned from practicing law in the U.S. District Court here, is
