No, we don't remember whose testimony mentioned the first name of the SS agent who was told of Hunt's involvement by the DC cops and then told Ehrlichman. However, if it's not in Ehrlichman's testimony I'd look first in that of Henry Peterson or Kleindienst, with Magruder, Odle more remote possibilities.

In the meantime, while getting ready the enclosed San Jose incident file for you, I ran across the name of Lilburne Boggs, assistant director of the SS protective services, who issued a statement which you'll find in a NY Times story datelined San Clemente and dated 4 Nov 70. May not be the same Boggs, of course, but it's a possibility and hearing the name might refresh your memory. Hope I'm not misleading you.
