## Nixon, Colson Granted Delay in Depositions

U.S. District Court Judge Joseph C. Waddy ruled yesterday that proposed depositions of President Nixon and former White House special counsel Charles W. Colson should be postponed at least until after March 1.

Waddy has scheduled a hearing then on a motion of the Finance Committee to Reelect the President to dismiss a suit filed by Common Cause, which is seeking to determine the accuracy of a committee report on donations made before the current campaign financing law went into effect April 7, 1972. Common Cause has sought the Nixon and Colson depositions in connection with its suit.
