Gravel v. U.S. - Pub. Rights - Staff privilege - not priv. or crime
U.S. v. Callahan - murder - knowledge of crime
Brandenburg v. Hayes newspaper " " " "

Brewster & Gravel "involved a claim to privilege
far stronger than the Press' claim to its privilege"
because the latter explicitly confers certain
immunities to members beyond

Press - Brewster "It can hardly be thought
that the ... clause ... protects minimal activity
priv. not in constitution. It is sup power specific
in constitution

all Nixon's opponents agreed in all these cases.
Full
Marbury v. Madison 1803 "it has been indisputable
under our constitutional system that
the decisions of the ultimate court must be respected &
obeyed by all"
