

Nixon, Stans Fail To File Appeal

Attorneys for President Nixon and former Commerce Secretary Maurice Stans failed to file an appeal yesterday of an order by U.S. District Judge George L. Hart Jr. that Nixon-Stans correspondence concerning federal job appointments be turned over to a Watergate grand jury.

Judge Hart had postponed the effective date of a July 24

ruling until yesterday to give attorneys the chance to file the appeal.

The papers, on which the President had claimed executive privilege, have been sought by a grand jury investigating allegations of job-buying by Nixon campaign contributors. Prosecutors are expected to pick up the documents today.
