

Watergate 'Agonizing' Trial For Nixon, Daughter Says

(AP) — Julie Nixon Eisenhower describes her father as “in an agonizing position” because of the Watergate scandal.

The President's younger daughter, addressing a news conference during the dedication of a \$3.4 million rehabilitation center for the crippled, said:

“I'm proud of my father and I'm sad to see this happen because I feel he's done so much for the country, I think this is hurting the Administration. I know he is doing everything in his power to get to the truth in Watergate.”

Courage Center

The dedication ceremonies were for Courage Center, operated by the Minnesota Society for Crippled Children and Adults, Inc.

Mrs. Eisenhower was asked why she agreed to participate since her father had vetoed a \$2.6 billion rehabilitation bill.

“The bill was not a good one,” she said. “He was re-elected on the promise that he wouldn't increase taxes and he felt the bill was too much money.”
