Bond, Freed

All five of the men charged in connection with the alleged attempted bugging June 17 of the Watergate offices of the Democratic National Committee are now free on bond.

Frank A. Sturgis, also known as Frank Fiorini, was the last of the five to be released when he posted \$50,000 bond yesterday in D.C. Superior Court. All five men are charged with second-degree burglary at this time.

According to testimony given before Acting Chief Judge James A. Belson, the \$5,000 cash payment for the Sturgis bond was provided by the Rev. Paul W. Force, a Miami-based Presbyterian clergyman and a friend of the Sturgis family. The bond was written by the Wisconsin Surety Co.
