**'Nixon-Agnew' Tactics**

**Attributed to Ford**

SOUTH BEND, Ind., Oct. 22 (UPI) — Democratic National Chairman Robert S. Strauss accused President Ford today of reverting to "Nixon-Agnew" campaign tactics in his warning that election of Democratic "extremists" could jeopardize world peace.

Strauss called on Mr. Ford to retract the statement, made in a speech at Oklahoma City.

"It's reminiscent of the 1970 campaign efforts of President Nixon and Vice President Agnew," Strauss said at a meeting he was attending here.
