# *Listing the Ins and Outs Of Washington Society*

The Green Book, Washington's putative last word on who is socially acceptable in the nation's capital, is out and so are some familiar names.

But Nelson A. Rockefeller is in and that comes as a surprise it seems, even to Carolyn Hagner Shaw, publisher of the green suedecloth-covered book more precisely known for the past 44 years as "The Social List of Washington, D.C."

He wasn't supposed to be. In an official announcement for release today, Mrs. Shaw notes that despite an "unprecedented" month's delay in coming off the presses caused by shifts in administration personnel following "the change in Presidents," the book omits some appointments which have not yet "jelled."

"For instance," the announcement pointed out, "the new 1975 edition does not list a Vice President."

Yet on page 121, leading off the section titled "The 93rd Congress of the United States," is the name of Nelson A. Rockefeller, identified as "The Vice President of the United States and President of the Senate (designate)."

"Thank heaven it says 'designate,'" said Mrs. Shaw when Rockefeller's name was called to her attention. "At least he's not in the key list."

According to Mrs. Shaw, her anonymous board of governors, which determines who gets in and who goes out each year, "went back and forth" on the Rockefeller listing. "There was so much confusion, but I was under the impression when the book went to press that he wasn't going to be in," Mrs. Shaw said.

If Rockefeller's listing is tenuous at best, it is only one of the hazards

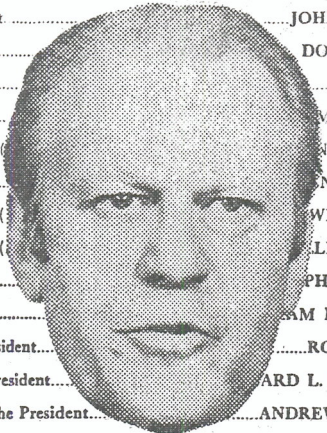
