LEGAL DEFENSE UNIT DISCLOSES BREAK-IN

The national headquarters of the N.A.A.C.P. Legal Defense and Educational Fund, Inc., was broken into on the same Labor Day weekend and in the same manner as was the office of Dr. Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist, and a tie-up between the events is being investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investi-

gation, the fund's director said yesterday.
Jack Greenberg, the director, said, "I really don't know if there is a connection, but we were engaged in things they [the Nixon Administration] might consider politically sensitive."

The break-in of the office of Dr. Ellsberg's psychiatrist in Beverly Hills, Calif., occurred on the evening of Sept. 3, 1971.

It was an operation conducted at the behest of the White House by G. Gordon Liddy and E. Howard Hunt Jr., the Watergate conspirators.
On Sept. 7, when office workers returned to work at the N.A.A.C.P. Fund at 10 Columbus Circle, they found that two filing cabinets had been opened. They contained minutes of board of directors meetings and other material.
