

PASADENA, Calif. (AP) — Private eye John Justice, who used to spend most of his time trailing husbands and wives, says the de-bugging business has become a major part of his activities.

"Watergate's created a wave of paranoia," he explained.

The 29-year-old investigator says he's made \$3,000 so far this year, at \$25 a room, on looking for listening devices. De-bugging brought in only \$100 two years ago.
