## Dairyman Urges Release Of Nixon's Data on Parity

LOUISVILLE, Ky., Aug. 6 (UPI)—An official of Dairymen Inc., a cooperative that contributed to President Nixon's 1972 campaign, has urged the President to turn over "memoranda or tapes relating to the 1971 dairy parity price," according to a letter released today.

In a letter to Leonard Garment, special counsel to the President, Ben F. Morgan Jr., executive vice president of the Louisville-based cooperative, wrote:

"We would urge [the President], were it possible for him to do so, that he authorize release of any such memoranda or tapes relating to the 1971 dairy parity price." The documents are being sought in connection with a suit brought by the consumer advocate Ralph Nader, against the Department of Agriculture.

Mr. Morgan wrote that there had been no relationship between political contribution by the political arm of Dairymen Inc. and the milk price support decision by the Nixon Administration.
