**Gulf Oil Official  
Gets a Full Tank**

BOSTON, Jan. 31 (UPI)  
—Bernard Markwell, vice president of Gulf Oil Co., told a state legislature committee Wednesday that he pulled into a Gulf station in Concord, N.H., this week and had to throw his weight around to get gas.

"It was about 6:30 at night and the owner had a big 'no gas' sign posted," Markwell said. "The owner was inside and I knocked on the window and signaled for him to come out.

"He came out and told me he was out of gas. 'Like heck you are, I said. Do you know who I am? I'm a vice president of Gulf Oil' . . . when he recognized the name, he filled up my tank."
