

Helm 5/24/73 AM David Worsley FBI Chief Counsel questioned

Director CENT. INTEL 4/30/66 - 2/2/73 Begin with it 47

He'd been told Hunt et al of help to him. (Liam Hunt "Over the years" in exam told me some stuff that can be bought any where. No such thing as a "clandestine" copy got back up when Hunt asked secret return of secretary from Paris & secret assign ment to him, secretly, on belt. Ref to "additional requests" the Hunt was making "that was" unacceptable" Told Cashman to knock it off

Fielding job - learned end with May this year, on 1st, from for news paper. Hunt stayed out of F's home, not office. No CIA stuff and a couple in briefcases. Know of left request for people on EL's bay. Hunt Young told of his assign- ment. He put my hands with Howard Osborne (Osborn?)

Purpose of "people" to understand and not nations. When Helms turned down, Young "plea with me" on its extreme urgency. Parable prepared for Young "found to be uncut is fast" & Young said "alright we will try to get you more material. And he did" Around version prepared. Hunt asked left people in on people "not to inform me of his presence" at left mtg. CIA interest weekend of weekend. During weekend Osborne knew names of Hunt's Commission, Osborne was "direct a operability" (odd Helms makes no mention of Melrod but talks of "these 4- CIA people") By Monday left knew "he was somewhere in the area when the break-in took place"

Helms Hunt both retired "at different times" in 1970. Day before his mtg at left had conversation with Gray - many at that time. Helms ^{emotional} ~~there~~ Re agency had nothing to do with the left break-in!

mtg Elms rd from West wing office 1 p.m. He + Walter, then H + E. Come in. He did most of talking. Elms just nodded head mostly.

"I learned from that the agency had had nothing to do with it" "They" were concerned about FBI in Mexico - independently "connected with the Bay of Pigs in Mexico" Helms said "legendary" and "attitude" "I don't know what they saw into in that" "at his point the information to Mexico that was grade unclear to me."

"Pushed" to join domestic area "but I forwarded to them... no way" Complaints to him FBI not doing its job. Why not resign.

"I thought I would take care of the agency better where I was."

"I did the best I could to keep the agency free & clear & heading straight"

(If he quit, Norman appointed successor, not asked)

Why request not direct to Helms "Ours being talked around" "I wondered at the time to why" it was waitress being direct with W.H. "It was being made so clear" That he left because of this way, he did nothing

Quincy? C/T to Quincy to learn, no direct reporting to Nixon, or work.

There was an official intelligence agencies' operation on "Cables" Had mtgs in one office, with cabinet members there. Could bypass (impersonal) to leaders only "unauthorized" as common only prohibited by law. But Arthur Helmsman, have there? "I would not consider that paper."

Quincy - Hunt's assignments. Bay Pigs. Others "Hunt for me to recall" Duty question "How often does the CIA help out former employees in the loan of equipment" It was to W.H., not Hunt. Says he didn't understand why he didn't get these things for himself. Quincy says he had some questions. Helms didn't catch it.

"Did it even occur to anyone to go to the Pres of the US and apprise him of these things that were going on in the WH." For all the world as though Quincy didn't know it could not be done - another duty question - to exculpate Nixon

Baker's business - request for Liddy "at the request of Mr H"
rather than a WTT request which it was.

CIA put her today - dropped by leaving film in camera.

"inherent reference" & Bay Puy. "I reacted to that suggestion very strongly." "I didn't care what any investigation had to say about the Bay of Pigs... I did not care." "I don't see" "didn't make any difference to me." "I knew nothing about this so 'inquired it to president' & ascertain facts

(Nobody says that if FBI found anything of real national security concern, the FBI would have let it go no further)

"I didn't know what the FBI had on their minds" or "might have" - or - was it going to put him on CIA?

"Do you feel that this might have been one of the reasons you were talked around at by way of the 23rd" He has such thoughts. Even that to Walters "thought it was because he was an Army officer & used to talking about Baker?" Again tries to tie CIA to Fielding & not would only be used in an interview. Look how would you

break into an office with that equipment.
"Why didn't you launch any inquiry" never used for any illegal act.

Baker tells things about whether his men would be involved - launched an unrec'd int'l inquiry & gave all to FBI
Baker even asks if they were arrested the men - who were then in jail.
