There seems to be a reluctance to accept my analysis/conc; usion that E. Howard Hunt is not some "Eduardo" but is really "Frank Bender." This is absed on the reporting by Schelsinger and others that Bender is a German refugee named Droller. Buried in a NYTimes story of 10/18/72, mixed in with in dequate reference to "un't employment by Mullen, is this:"... Washington sources have identified Mr. Hunt as a prime organizer of the Bay of Pigs..."

Now being some kind of flunky under "Bender" would not justify the description of Hunt as a "prime" organizer. Outside of Washington, this had to be the man in charge in the field. There is the possibility the Times language is a bit loose. My view is that THE prime organizers were in Washington and that aside from them the only one who can de described as "prime" is the field-operations chief. HW 10/25/72
