Who's Who in America for 1972-73 has showed up at the Mill Valley library, and attached is a copy of the listing for Hunt. Note he gives the White House as his office address. Jenifer has made out a note listing the differences between this entry and the last previous. She also has updated her chart on all listings for him in the light of this 1972-73 entry and the first entry which we found and sent to you earlier. Unfortunately this does not copy well on our copier, so when I can get to<sup>a</sup>Xerox I'll make two good copies and send them as soon as possible.

We find no Toterdale or Totterdale in either Who's Who or Contemporary Authors.

In CA we note that the listing for Dietrich gives his birthday at 1928 and his father's name as Dietrich also, or course, but the 1928 birthdate is interesting compared with his own listed as 1918 in Who's Who. CA also lists Dietrich's birthplace as Washington, D.C.

CA lists only the Gordon Davis pseudonym, with a simple reference, See Dietrich etc. The other pseudonym, John Baxter, is not mentioned.
