

Hunt Will Appear On Television Show

E. Howard Hunt Jr. is scheduled to tape a television show in San Francisco today with his long-time friend, William F. Buckley.

Hunt will appear on Buckley's show, Firing Line, which is to be aired in Washington at 10 p.m. Sunday on Channel 26.

Buckley said yesterday that he and Hunt, who pleaded guilty last week to all six charges against him in the Watergate bugging, have been close friends for two decades.

In a telephone interview yesterday, Buckley said, "Howard and I have been friends since 1951 when we were both living in Mexico. Howard was working for the CIA and I saw a great deal of Howard and his wife Dorothy."

Buckley added that "Howard's children and my sister's children have gone to school for several years together." In a newspaper column last fall, Buckley said he was godfather to three of the Hunt children.

Buckley said yesterday that he saw Hunt in December, two weeks after his wife was killed, "and, as a matter of fact I've been made sole trustee to the Hunt children." Dorothy Hunt was killed in a Chicago plane crash on December 8.
