

Q: William F. Buckley Jr. was of draft age and out of college during the Korean War. Why wasn't he drafted? JOSEPH S. DOYLE

A: He was. But for World War II in 1944. He went to Officer Candidate School and was sent to the counter-intelligence section at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, the day the war ended. He spent part of his remaining time teaching sex hygiene to non-English-speaking recruits.
