

At the time of her death Dorothy Hunt was wearing or carrying a small pin that had on it the name "Junion Bowman". It is itemized in her estate. Lesar was to have made a quick examination at the court house yesterday afternoon, W to see what papers are there and the copying cost. Anyway, I checked my cards and find one Bowman only in those on WG, Jack Bowman, ex-CIA friend of E. Howard, mentioned in January. Howard as administrator are in a story in today's local paper, from its Rockville Bureau. Howard sole heir, next if he had died the children. Will dates to 1967.
