**Wealthy Candidate  
Urges Tax Reform**

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 27 (UPI)—A well-to-do gubernatorial candidate cites his own income tax record as evidence that tax reform laws are needed.

William Matson Roth, a wealthy shipping executive and a Democrat, revealed Monday he had paid no federal income taxes from 1962 through 1965 and no state income tax for the year 1970. In 1970 his adjusted gross income was \$116,206; his deductions were \$191,298.

Roth proposed allowing fewer deductions because "the minimum tax payment, as now structured, is insufficient . . ."
