**Firing of Jaworski
Called Possibility**

HOUSTON, July 12 (UPI) — The president of the American Bar Association said Thursday there's a good chance Watergate Special Prosecutor Leon Jaworski will be fired, especially if he wins his Supreme Court case against President Nixon.

"I think there is some possibility Mr. Jaworski may be terminated or fired, Chesterfield Smith of Lakeland, Fla., said. He said the action would probably depend on the outcome of the executive privilege case now before the Supreme Court.

Jaworski's predecessor, Archibald Cox, was fired by Mr. Nixon because he tried to obtain copies of Watergate-related tape recordings. Jaworski has asked the Supreme Court to order Mr. Nixon to release the tapes, which the President said defies his executive privilege.
