As of yesterday Sussman was surprised I'd not heard. I didn't expect more, but I felt that with the paper on strike there would be more time to check and follow up. Because I didn't really expect to hear from the Post and was doing what I regarded as a duty, after an hour I called the Star. You know, the competition, the Journalistic Avis? Well, that guy on that national desk though it is a great stroy, too. His one question: would I be home Monday (which is two days from now)? I told him I would be. HW 11/3/73
