THANKS FOR YOUR LETTERS OF 10/29 AND 11/2. MY NEW TYPEWRITER IS ON THE BLINK, SO THIS WILL BE BRIEF.

STAFF TC; THAT CD SHOWS HOW LITTLE MANY OF THEM KNEW ABOUT WHAT THE OTHERS WERE DOING. IT MIGHT BE INTERESTING NOW; I SKIMMED IT & DIDN'T GET ANY PAGES. IT MIGHT BE WORTH THE EFFORT FOR YOU OR BOB TO REVIEW IT.
