Agent Oswald-Hudkins-Jaworski-Martin Waldron

Martin Waldron called me this morning about a 10-anniv. roundup. The said he was in Miami working on Guban-ixon aspects of the Watergate. We started rambling early, into many things, and never did finish the purpose of his call.

When he started talking about Jake Floyd and George Parr and the pistoleros, and the assassination of Parr's son by Mexican traced to a team of 8-10 at a Clint Murcheson rank in Texas, I asked if I could tape, he agreed, and beginning there I did tape, but I did not motice immediately when side 1 ended.

He is to come up for a couple of days.

He does not recall where he heard the story, but he was told that it is Leon Jaworski who had Lonnie Hudkins fired after the attention to his story. He has never discussed this with Lonnie. He is firm and clear in the recollection that Lonnio was fired over the story and that it is Jaworski who cansed it.

If this is true, it is possible that it occurred after Haworski was special counsel to the Texas Court of Inquiry.
