Aide Cuts Off Pardon Queries

WASHINGTON (AP) President Ford's chief spokesman indicated Friday there will be no further explanation of the Sunday pardon for Richard M. Nixon until Mr. Ford holds a news conference "in the very near future."

Acting White House Press Secretary John W. Hushen was questioned for the sixth straight day about Mr. Ford's decision to pardon the former President in advance of any legal action against Nixon.

Hushen said that was the question only Mr. Ford could answer and suggested it be put to him at a news conference, which he said would occur soon.
