They've finally settled scores. Donna Bradshaw, daughter of insurance magnate W. Clement Stone, will get the Rolls Royce and the \$250,000 apartment. Her estranged husband gets the Cadillac, yacht and limousine.

Mrs. Bradshaw, 39, charged her second husband, David, 47, had "ripped (her) off" by mismanaging her money. Mrs. Bradshaw, who estimated her wealth at \$38 million, filed suit to dissolve their business partnership and also filed a divorce petition, which was put off with the temporary agreement.

Mrs. Bradshaw charged her husband with making investments without her knowledge. Among those investments, she said, was \$15,000 in contributions to President Nixon's 1972 campaign.
