Two Boston men, ^{5/25/74} con-
vinced that "if you liked the
book, you'll love the movie,"
are preparing a videotaped,
40-hour dramatization of the
edited White House tran-
scripts of President Nixon's
Watergate-related conversa-
tions.

"Bleeps" will be heard
where "expletives deleted"
appear in the printed text
and, according to Webster
Lithgow of The Transcripts

Film Co., inaudible or unin-
telligible references will be
treated with appropriate
sounds.

Professional actors will
portray the roles of Mr.

Nixon and his aides. Li-
thgow and his associate,
Thomas McCann, plan to of-
fer the dramatization to net-
work or independent TV sta-
tions for syndication.
