3 VIETNAM VETERANS ARE FREED ON BOND

TALLAHASSEE, Fla., July 20 (UPI)—Three members of Vietnam Veterans Against the War posted bonds totaling \$75,000 today and walked away after a week in jail calling the Federal conspiracy charges against them "garbags"

Scott Camil of Gainesville, John W. Kniffin of Austin, Tex., and Peter P. Mahoney of New Orleans were welcomed by about a dozen supporters, who raised clenched fists and shouted encouragement as the three were led into the clerk's office at the Federal District Court. After they signed their release

After they signed their release papers, they were freed.

The three were freed on \$25,000 bond each pending trial on charges that they conspired to touch off an armed rebellion during the Republican National Convention Aug. 21-24. Three other members of the antiwar group are in custody in connection with the charges. All six had been indicted by a Federal grand jury.
