Probe Is Asked Of Kerry's Race

BOSTON, May 31 (UPI)—John F. Kerry, a national organizer of the Vietnam Veterans Against the War, wants the Senate Watergate Committee to investigate whether White House intervention caused him to lose his bid for a seat in Congress last year.

"I have been in touch with the committee concerning a number of things, mostly in regards to the Vietnam Veterans Against the War," Kerry said yesterday. "But the discussions have also concerned my campaign and White House interest in it. It's hard to separate the two."

Kerry lost last November to Paul R. Cronin (R-Mass.) by 6,600 votes.
