MRS. TIPPIT IS THE WIDOW OF POLICE OFFICER J.D. TIPPIT WHO WAS SLAIN LAST NOV. 22 AS HE ATTEMPTED TO ARREST LEE HARVEY OSWALD, ACCUSED AS THE KILLER OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

THE DISTRIBUTION OF DONATIONS SENT FROM ACROSS THE NATION TO THE TIPPIT FAMILY WAS DETERMINED IN A FRIENDLY SUIT FILED BY THE CITY OF DALLAS, WHICH HAD HELD THE FUNDS UNTIL NOW.

THE MONEY CAME FROM 42,000 DONORS.

LAWYER JOHN CRAWFORD, REPRESENTING THE TIPPITS, SAID THE CHILDREN'S SHARE WILL BE SET UP IN A TRUST FUND AT A BANK.

"THEY'LL BE ABLE TO TAKE OUT THE MONEY WHEN THEY NEED IT," HE SAID. THE TRUSTEES ARE MRS. TIPPIT AND THE BANK.

ALL DONATIONS WERE GIVEN TO THE TIPPITS EXCEPT FOR \$3,708 WHICH WAS EARMARKED FOR THE DALLAS POLICEMEN'S AND FIREMEN'S WELFARE FUND.
