Mrs. Marie Tippit, widow of the slain police officer, received a check for \$312,916.62. In addition \$330,946.46 was given Mrs. Tippit and J. Donald Squibb, trust officer for Republic National Bank, to be held in trust for the three Tippit children -- Charles Allen, Brenda Kay and Curtis Glenn -- and \$3,716.16 went to the city police and firemen's welfare fund.

Distribution of the money was authorized by Dist Judge Dee Brown Walker last week.
