MRS. TIPPIT (110)

DALLAS, TEX., JAN. 29 (AP)-MRS. J. D. TIPPIT, THE WIDOW OF A DALLAS POLICEMAN KILLED SHORTLY AFTER PRESIDENT KENNEDY WAS ASSASSINATED, HAS REMARRIED.

DALLAS POLICE LT. HARRY DEAN THOMAS SAID LAST NIGHT THAT HE AND MRS. TIPPIT WERE MARRIED A WEEK AGO. THEY ARE RESIDING IN DALLAS.

SHE HAS THREE CHILDREN AND HE HAS FOUR.

THE WARREN COMMISSION NAMED LEE HARVEY OSWALD AS OFFICER J. D. TIPPIT'S SLAYER. IT ALSO SAID OSWALD ASSASSINATED PRESIDENT KENNEDY. BOTH KILLINGS HAPPENED ON NOV. 22, 1963.

DONORS FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD GAVE MRS. TIPPIT MORE THAN \$650,000 IN CONTRIBUTIONS AFTER HER HUSBAND WAS SLAIN.

N TYTMAS SAID HE AND HIS WIFE SPENT THEIR HONEYMOON ON THE GULF COAST AND IN SOUTH TEXAS. HE RETURNED TO DUTY YESTERDAY.

DALLAS, TEX., FIRST ADD MRS. TIPPIT (A29DN) XX DUTY YESTERDAY. THE PAIR WERE MARRIED JAN. 21 IN THE BECKLEY HILLS BAPTIST CHURCH IN DALLAS' OAK CLIFF SECTION BY THE REV. LARRY YOUNG, PASTOR OF THE CHURCH.

THE REV. MR. YOUNG SAID HE HAD KNOWN THOMAS "FOR A LITTLE MORE THAN A YEAR."

"HE'S A MEMBER OF MY CONGREGATION," THE PASTOR SAID. ON QUESTIONING, HE SAID THOMAS WAS A DIVORCEE WHOSE FORMER WIFE WAS A TEACHER, A MEMBER OF THE FACULTY AT NORTH TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY IN DENTON.

THE REV. MR. YOUNG SAID THAT MRS. TIPPIT HAD BEEN A MEMBER OF HIS CONGREGATION EVER SINCE HE HAD BEEN PASTOR OF THE CHURCH BUT THAT A FORMER PASTER OFFICIATED AT THE FUNERAL FOR J.D. TIPPIT.

DURING THE MONTHS FOLLOWING THE ASSASSINATION, MRS. TIPPIT RECEIVED THOUSANDS OF LETTERS INCLUDING MONEY DONATIONS. THE FINAL TOTAL WAS \$647,579 ON WHICH SHE WAS REQUIRED TO PAY NO INCOME TAX.

A JUDGE AUTHORIZED ABOUT HALF OF IT FOR A TRUST FUND FOR THE TIPPIT CHILDREN. THE WIDOW RECEIVED MOST OF THE REMAINDER.

BUT MRS. TIPPIT WENT ON NO SPENDING SPREE. SHE FINALLY BOUGHT A NEW CAR AND A COLOR TELEVISION SET. BUT YEARS AFTER THE ASSASSINATION, HER FURNITURE, HOME AND NEIGHBORHOOD REMAINED MODEST.

"I WANT THE CHILDREN TO GROW UP

"I WANT THE CHILDREN TO GROW UP JUST LIKE THEY WOULD HAVE IF J.D. WERE STILL WITH US," SHE SAID. "I WANT THEM TO LEARN TO EARN THEIR WAY IN THE WORLD JUST THE WAY THEIR FATHER HAD TO DO. IF YOU MAKE IT EASY FOR THEM THEY WON'T KNOW HOW WHEN THEY GROW UP."
