**300 Honor Kennedy**  
**At Dallas Ceremony**

DALLAS, Nov. 21 (UPI)—  
About 300 persons gathered  
in a cold wind at Kennedy  
Memorial Plaza today for 30  
minutes of music and prayer  
to eulogize President John F.  
Kennedy one day ahead of  
the 10th anniversary of his  
assassination.

Mrs. J. B. Shaw, an elderly  
woman who sat with bowed  
head in a folding chair,  
summed up what a Catholic  
bishop, a rabbi, a Protestant  
clergyman and Mayor Wes  
Wise were to say later.

"I ha da special regard  
for President Kennedy," Mrs.  
Shaw said. "He was the fin-  
est of men—a great leader."
